Subject: Advisory for Aspirants on Filling of College & Programme Preferences — UG Admissions, Academic Session 2026–27.

Admissions to the Undergraduate (UG) programmes of Government Degree Colleges of Jammu & Kashmir for the Academic Session 2026–27 are currently underway through the Centralised Admission Portal <https://jkadmissions.in>. It has been observed that a number of aspirants are not filling their college and programme preferences properly — by submitting too few preferences — thereby risking non-admission. In their own interest, all aspirants are hereby advised as follows:

- 1. Importance of Preference Filling:** Filling a sufficient number of well-considered college and programme preferences is critical. Aspirants who submit only a few preferences risk not being allotted any seat. All aspirants must therefore fill their preferences carefully and completely. This maximises the chance of allotment and helps avoid the rush of college-hopping during the Spot Round.
- 2. Preferences Can Be Updated:** Aspirants may add to or update their submitted preferences any number of times up to the last date for submission of forms. Aspirants are therefore advised to review and refine their preferences before the window closes.
- 3. Explore Courses Before Filling Preferences:** Aspirants should explore the relevant courses available across all colleges before filling their preferences. The various course combinations offered by different colleges may be explored using the 'Courses' link available at <https://directorcollegesjk.in>. Aspirants may also view the college profiles and facilities of various colleges on the Directorate's website. Having explored these, aspirants should accordingly fill informed preferences on the Admission Portal, <https://jkadmissions.in>.
- 4. Daily Tentative Rank List:** A tentative rank list for every College and Course shall be made available on the Admission Portal, where an aspirant can see whether or not they are likely to secure admission in a particular course, based on their merit and the number of vacancies of that programme in that college. This rank list shall be published every day. Aspirants are advised to check it daily and revise their preferences

accordingly. The number of seats per programme is tentative, and the rank list is therefore also tentative. The figures are indicative and may change as more candidates register and submit their preferences during the open window.

5. **Follow the Official WhatsApp Channel:** For fast and regular updates, aspirants should follow the official WhatsApp Channel for Admissions 2026-27, the link to which is available on the Admission Portal, <https://jkadmissions.in>.

All aspirants and their parents/guardians are advised to make full use of the above facilities and of the Counselling & Facilitation Centres established at every Government Degree College of J&K, and to refer to the detailed Admission Notice and Registration Manual available on <https://jkadmissions.in>, so as to make informed choices and avoid mistakes in preference filling.
